

## The Planning Framework




This ensures the right mechanisms are in place for a streamlined planning process and the effective delivery of Special Activation Precincts.



#### **Planning Legislation**

- Working within current planning legislation to streamline processes
- Makes it easier for investors to determine the correct planning pathway
- Provides certainty about the zoning and process for development



#### **Master Plans**

- Brings forward the upfront strategic planning that removes the need for industry to do this
- Provides precinct wide solutions that manages impacts
- Certainty for investors and the community about what type of development can happen where




#### **Delivery Mechanisms**

- A collaborative approach that supports innovation and best practice
- Provides detailed plans for development and government funded infrastructure
- Strategies for the protection of the environment, amenity and cultural heritage
- Monitoring and reporting

### Why Narrabri?



- Capitalise on the Inland Rail and Northern NSW Inland Port.
- Diversify economy to enhance its traditional agriculture and manufacturing industries and future proof against drought.
- New housing, health, education, social and community infrastructure to support the growing population.
- Respect the values of the Gamilaroi people and their connection to Country.
- Create economic growth by putting Narrabri on the map as a supplier of cost-effective energy intensive manufacturing and production.
- Opportunity to create more local jobs for local people.
- The precinct will provide a range of land uses to accommodate new and emerging industries.



### Where are we up to?



- Baseline reports were completed in early 2022 across a range of disciplines such as:
  - > flooding,
  - biodiversity,
  - hydrogeology,
  - climate change and
  - air, noise and odour.
- The findings from the baseline reports informed the development of four scenarios for the Narrabri Special Activation Precinct.
- Early community consultation occurred in Narrabri in December 2021 with ongoing engagement occurring.
- An Aboriginal Enquiry by Design was undertaken ahead of the Preliminary Enquiry by Design to invite input to the process that included opportunities and challenges for consideration

### Preliminary Enquiry by Design - 29 / 30 March



- A Preliminary Enquiry by Design (EbD) workshop was held on 29th and 30th of March 2022 to develop four land use scenarios to be considered as part of the SAP master plan process.
- The workshop also explored opportunities outside the SAP, including opportunities for long term residential growth, active transport and activation of areas


 All ideas are being tested to help inform the next stage.
