## **Growing Regional Economies Fund**

Closes: 23rd of May 2023 - 5:00 pm Value: \$2 Million to \$30 Million

Run By: NSW Department of Regional NSW

The Growing Regional Economies Fund aims to accelerate economic development and prosperity in regional NSW, increase the appeal of investing in regional NSW, support investment in major transformational projects that increase employment opportunities in regional areas and ensure that regional communities have the infrastructure and services required for sustainable growth.

The Fund also has a focus on enabling infrastructure that will support investment in regional housing projects to meet demand generated by growth in employment and economic activity.

#### Regional Investment Activation Fund - Stream Two

Ongoing Until Program Closes: 31st of December 2024 or until expended

Value: \$1 Million to \$10 Million

Run By: NSW Government Department of Regional NSW

This grant supports projects that are time-sensitive and strategically significant for a priority industry or location. Projects may be recommended for funding support under the Regional Investment Activation Fund.

The \$110 million Regional Investment Activation Fund will co-invest with eligible entities on projects that will deliver, significant economic, social and/or environmental benefits for a priority industry or location.

The objectives of the grant are to:

- Support the growth of existing industries and the establishment of new/emerging industries where regional NSW has a strong actual or potential competitive advantage
- · Activate the economic potential of Special Activation Precincts, Regional Job Precincts, Renewable Energy Zones, hydrogen hubs and other priority locations through increased private sector investment
- Create new high quality employment opportunities
- · Support the shift towards higher-value-added activities and participation in global value chains and supply chains
- Promote collaboration between businesses, education and research institutions and other parties through sharing of knowledge, resources and infrastructure.

## Coles Nurture Fund - Round 11

Run By: Coles

Coles launched the \$50 million Nurture Fund in April 2015 to help Australian food and liquor producers innovate and grow.

Since then, they have offered more than \$30 million in financial support to more than 90 small and medium sized businesses. From Australia's first quinoa processing facility, to fence posts made from recycled plastic, and a state of the art factory to grow grass indoors, the Coles Nurture Fund is helping Aussie producers bring their big ideas to life.

Australian producers can apply for a grant of up to \$500,000 to help them develop new market-leading products, technologies and processes.
